EPA has reviewed the proposed reassignment of sites as stated in Mr. P. A Rakowski's letter dated December 22, 1992. EPA concurs with the proposed addition of site 74 to Operable Unit #4 (site 69) in light of the potential for chemical surety agent contaminants. EPA concurs that OU 4 (sites 69 and 74) are now on the same schedule and OU5 (site 2) is on the schedule approved in the FY93 Site Management Plan.

The revised schedule for OU4 should be submitted as soon as possible.

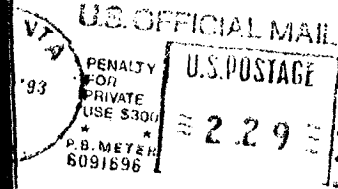
