Dear Ms. Landman:

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has completed its review of the above subject documents. There is a minor concern with the proposed no action alternative. There are areas of groundwater which exceed the MCL and NCWQS limits. Although, there is only hit slightly above the primary groundwater standards, North Carolina does not make a distinction between primary and secondary. If the State agrees to a no action plan of action then EPA will support the decision. However, if this is not the case then it will be EPA's recommendation to provide a semiannual monitoring plan (to show consistency in data) and impose water use restrictions.
