Dear Ms. Landman:

I am pleased to submit on behalf of Baker Environmental, Inc. (Baker) three bound and three unbound copies of the Final RI Report for Operable Unit (OU) No. 13, MCB Camp Lejeune, North Carolina. Two copies of the Final RI have been forwarded to Mr. Neal Paul at MCB Camp Lejeune. Additional copies of the report have also been distributed according to the attached transmittal letters. Lastly, Technical Review Committee members have been notified that the report may be obtained at their request.

The Final RI concludes that site-related risks pose neither current nor future threats to potential human and ecological receptors. Accordingly, both the Draft Proposed Remedial Action Plan (PRAP) and the Draft Record of Decision (ROD) detail a "No Further Remedial Action Alternative." To date, comments regarding both the Draft PRAP and ROD documents have not been received from all government agencies. Because the public comment period is scheduled to begin December 1, 1996, we will need to obtain the remaining comments, revise the PRAP, and submit a Final PRAP at least one week prior to the start of the comment period. I do not anticipate the need to prepare a Draft Final PRAP due to the lack of issues regarding the site; however, a Draft Final ROD will most likely be required. We can discuss future submittals after the comments are received.
