
Dear Dr. Stehman:

The semi-annual monitoring report (January - June 1997) for Operable Unit No. 5 (Site 2) is forwarded as the enclosure. This report includes procedures, analytical findings, and subsequent recommendations of the monitoring program for this site at Marine Corps Base (MCB), Camp Lejeune. Monitoring program activities for this site was implemented in response to the Record of Decision document signed by MCB, Camp Lejeune on September 15, 1994.

This enclosed document has incorporated the Notice of Non-Significant Changes dated 31 July 1997. These changes have been implemented to reflect a decrease in the number of yearly sampling events from four to two; elimination of sampling for three supply wells; the addition of sampling of two monitoring wells; and the elimination of groundwater analysis for total metals, dissolved solids, and suspended solids. During this sampling period, a number of well head maintenance and security activities also took place. These activities included clearing and removing debris on and around the well head; painting ballards and protective casings; and the installation of new locks.

The enclosed document has been prepared by Baker Environmental, Inc. and submitted to the Naval Facilities Engineering Command, Atlantic Division; MCB, Camp Lejeune; United States Environmental Protection Agency; and the North Carolina Department of Environment and Natural Resources in Raleigh.
