Dear Mr. Brant:

Enclosed please find one (1) copy of the Final Draft Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS) Work Plan and Health and Safety Plan (HASP) for the referenced Contract Task Order. These documents include revisions based on comments received by the EPA Region IV, North Carolina Department of Environmental Health and Natural Resources, and LANTDIV. The RI/FS Sampling and Analysis Plan, which includes the Field Sampling and Analysis Plan and the Quality Assurance Project Plan will be submitted next week per our discussion on April 8, 1992.

The Draft Final RI/FS Work Plan has been rescoped so that all necessary information to characterize the site, assess human health and environmental risks, and evaluate remedial alternatives will be collected in a single field program. However, it should be recognized that it is still possible that additional investigations at these sites may be required to evaluate remedial alternatives. These investigations may include aquifer testing, which cannot be adequately scoped at this time based on existing information, or additional sampling and analysis to further define areas that may not be apparent during the onsite field investigation but are identified upon receipt of data from the laboratory.

Copies of the RI/FS Work Plan and HASP have been forwarded to Mr. George Radford (Camp Lejeune EMD), Mr. Jack Butler (DEHNR), and Ms. Michelle Glenn (EPA Region IV) in accordance with LANTDIV's Scope of Work dated July 23, 1991 (appended to Order for Supplies and Services, Form 1155, signed July 31, 1991). Ms. Glenn's copy has been forwarded via express mail in order to meet the submittal date.


